



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
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Beyoncé's journey to the world stage began as a founding member of the internationally successful \frown group Destiny's Child. Today, she wears many hats, including mother, singer, songwriter, producer, director, actress, philanthropist and businesswoman. She has won 17 Grammy awards setting a record for the female artist with the most wins in a single year. With four #1 solo albums, she is \checkmark currently working on her fifth studio album in the midst of her sold out Mrs. Carter Show World Tour.

For more than 20 years, Timothy "Timbaland" Mosley's innovative sound has redefined how the world experiences music. As the most sought-after producer with multi-platinum collaborations with hundreds of artists including Justin

collaborations with hundreds of artists including Justin Timberlake, Elton John, Missy Elliott, Madonna, and JAY Z, Timbaland was Billboard Magazine's Song Writer of the Decade (2011) and is a multi-Grammy Award winner. Timbaland is a global icon surpassing time and genre.



Italian pop singersongwriter Laura Pausini is a powerhouse of international proportions. Having released her eponymous debut album in 1993 while still in high school, she has since gone on to receive four World Music Awards, three Latin Grammy Awards and was the first Italian female artist to win a Grammy Award. Pausini has released sophisticated and melodic pop albums in Italian, Spanish and English, proving that her classic and powerful voice knows no bounds.



Actress, entertainer, music artist, film & TV producer, fashion designer, entrepreneur and humanitarian Jennifer Lopez is one of the most powerful and celebrated celebrities in entertainment. Lopez transformed the global music scene, selling over 75 million records worldwide and is the first woman in history to have a #1 movie and #1 album in the same week. Her commitment to making a difference and her passion for making this world better is highlighted through The Lopez Family Foundation.



Recording artist, concert performer and philanthropist John Legend has won nine Grammy awards and was named one of Time magazine's 100 most influential people. Throughout his career, John has worked to make a difference in the lives of others. John was awarded the 2010 BET Humanitarian of the Year award, the 2009 CARE Humanitarian Award for Global Change, and the 2012 Harvard Foundation Artist of the Year Award.



As her debut album, Lights, made so thrillingly clear, Ellie Goulding's voice is utterly distinctive and unforgettable, using her voice as a skilled instrumentalist would. A musical, vocal and lyrical tempest, her new record Halcyon arrived to great applause. She is a Brit award recipient, has sung at the White House, performed at the wedding of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge, and holds a number one pop record that has done over 3 million in America.



Brit nominated Rita Ora began singing at 6 years old. This is where the magic started. Born in war-torn Kosovo and raised in London's West End, Rita has a natural propensity toward mixing street-beats with pop. Her debut platinum album Ora was number 1 in the UK and included 3 number 1 singles. With support slots on the DJ Fresh and Coldplay tours this year, she's ready.



The debut album Florence Welch dreamt up in her bedroom in South London burst into being and swept the planet, selling over three million copies, winning the coveted Brits 'Best Album' award and etching itself indelibly into the popular consciousness. Ceremonials, her second album, has sold a phenomenal 1.8 million copies worldwide and made Top 10 in twelve different countries, achieving platinum status in six of those.



Shawn "JAY Z" Carter is a 17-time Grammy award winner, founder and Chairman of Rocawear, and majority owner of the 40/40sports clubs. JAY Z served as President and CEO of Def Jam Recordings before forming the entertainment company Roc Nation. With the most #1 albums by any solo artist, his album Watch The Throne marked his 12th #1 album debut. JAY Z continues his philanthropic work through his Shawn Carter Foundation, and in April 2013 announced Roc Nation Sports.



Talent, excitement, chemistry, laughter, and style – this is HAIM. The LA sisters have butterflies for a reason: Danielle, Este and Alana Haim have waited years to set their R&B, pop radio and classic rock inspired songs free. Electric talent, fiery resolve and sparkling character, these three Valley girls have completed a sold-out headline tour of Europe, arena support slots with Florence + The Machine, and were winners of the BBC's Sound of 2013 annual poll.



Iggy Azalea has risen to the status of one of the most promising new MCs in a new era of hip-hop. Hailing from the small New South Wales town of Mullumbimby, the mixtape which first garnered her mainstream attention, Ignorant Art, was an impressive, raw statement. She is the first ever woman to be named to XXL's Freshman list and has gained the support of rap royalty, from Dr. Dre to Snoop Dogg.



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
